The Specialist in masonry restoration works in the heritage sector. He works on the maintenance, restoration and repurposing of cultural heritage and is a professional in the field of preserving and restoring valuable cultural-historical masonry. The Specialist in masonry restoration often works in a company that is mainly concerned with preserving, repairing and renewing valuable cultural-historical masonry. Occasionally, he processes small-scale natural stone components.

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<p><b>Access to next level of education/professions</b>          Based on experience acquired and possibly following courses, the Specialist in masonry restoration can progress to various positions such as foreman or an office position (planner/calculator). He can also progress in his career by becoming and independent contractor. The Specialist in masonry restoration can transfer vertically to qualifications in higher professional education for monument restoration.</p>	<p><b>International agreements</b>          Specialist restoration bricklaying is not a regulated profession in the Netherlands. However, the education and training for this profession on qualification level 4 is regulated under the European directive 2005/36/EC, amended by directive 2013/55/EU. The regulated education and training gives access to regulated professions at the level of a diploma according to article 11 of this directive.</p>

## 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

<p>Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).          In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.          In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.</p>

<p><b>Entry requirements</b>          The certificate senior secondary vocational education (mbo) on qualification level 3, in a related discipline.</p>

<p>Dutch senior secondary VET is based on qualification files, that each contain one or more qualifications.
