## 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The All-round make-up and hair artist is mainly employed in the performance arts and the media sector. He/she carries out part of the preparatory work in a workshop, for example the production of hair pieces and prosthetics. An important part of the work is carried out on location: in the theatre, on the filmset or in the television or photo studio.

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<p><b>Access to next level of education/professions</b> The majority of career opportunities for the All-round make-up and hair artist are within the profession. The All-round make-up and hair artist can for example be awarded and take on increasingly complex assignments; be placed in charge of a group of make-up and hair artists collaborating on the same production; or further specialise for example in the field of wigmaker, special effects or 3D applications. After obtaining the diploma All-round make-up and hair artist, transfer is possible to another study course in senior secondary vocational education, for example for the qualification Salon manager or All-round beautician. Transfer to study courses in higher professional education is also possible, for example the study course theatre design, art and design, art direction, performance arts production, performance techniques production, theatre maker or drama teacher.</p>	<p><b>International agreements</b> All-round make-up and hair artist is not a regulated profession in the Netherlands. However, the education and training for this profession on qualification level 4 is regulated under the European directive 2005/36/EC, amended by directive 2013/55/EU. The regulated education and training gives access to regulated professions at the level of a diploma according to article 11 of this directive.</p>

## 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

<p>Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl). In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week. In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.</p>

<p><b>Entry requirements</b> The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) advanced vocational programme, combined programme, or theoretical programme, or a comparable level.</p>	

## 7. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Dutch senior secondary VET is based on qualification files, that each contain one or more qualifications. The information included in part 3 and 4 is derived directly from the qualification file determined by the Minister of Education, Culture and Science. Optional subjects are linked to the qualification. The optional subjects have a total size of 15% of the course duration. The optional subjects completed by the student are listed on the certificate.
