## 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The All-round instructor outdoor sports works at the interface between supervising outdoor sports activities with a focus on the experience of greenery and nature. This includes preparation and maintenance work in the outdoor space for outdoor sports activities. The instructor works in an environment in which activities aimed at outdoor sports and exercise are offered safely, ranging from short programmes lasting one to two hours through to multiyear training programmes aimed at recreational sports and outdoor sports. Instruction/training and preparation for outdoor sports can take place indoors and outdoors. The All round instructor outdoor sports can work in a variety of different organisations. He can be employed in an institution or government organisation or work as a freelancer or be employed by a private enterprise.

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<p><b>Access to next level of education/professions</b> The most obvious opportunities for advancement for the All-round instructor outdoor sports is transfer to the related level 4 study courses; for example Sport exercise and health coordinator (qualification file Sport and Exercise, or to another level 4 qualification from this qualification file) or to Supervisor or Foreman green space (qualification file Green space).</p>	<p><b>International agreements</b> All-round instructor outdoor sports is not a regulated profession in the Netherlands. However, the education and training for this profession on qualification level 3 is regulated under the European directive 2005/36/EC, amended by directive 2013/55/EU. The regulated education and training gives access to regulated professions at the level of a diploma according to article 11 of this directive.</p>

## 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

<p>Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl). In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week. In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.</p>

<p><b>Entry requirements</b> The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) advanced vocational programme, combined programme, or theoretical programme, or a comparable level.</p>
