4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The Able bodied seaman inland works on an inland shipping vessel on which goods and persons are transported economically on inland waterways between various loading, unloading and mooring places and destinations in Europe. The working vessels are of different types; this may influence the package of tasks. Examples are bulk shipping, container and cargo shipping, tanker shipping, ro-ro shipping, passenger shipping and push barge and tug operations. The Able bodied seaman inland performs a range of operational tasks on board an inland shipping vessel, such as tasks relating to the steering of the vessel, the management of the vessel, cargo handling, cargo stowage, the transport of passengers, ship engineering and structural aspects, maintenance and repair, communication and health.

<p>Access to next level of education/professions The Able bodied seaman inland can advance to the position of senior Able bodied seaman inland and following additional sailing time and obtaining the basic certificate marine radio operator can advance to the position of ship's mate inland shipping. Following additional training and sailing time, he can advance to the position of Skipper inland. The Able bodied seaman inland can also transfer directly to the senior secondary vocational education study course Skipper inland. 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

<p>Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl). In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week. In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.</p>
