A Stage and event technology worker can work at different organisations such as theatres, production houses, traveling companies, events, festivals and music venues, but also equipment rental companies and specialised employment agencies.

Access to next level of education/professions

The Stage and event technology worker can progress to Stage and event technician. With further training and experience, the Stage and event technology worker can progress to positions as podium technician, audio-visual assistant, audio-visual specialist, stage master, stage manager or head of technical services. Because the profession is physically demanding, career planning is essential.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.

Average duration of the education/ training leading to the certificate

2 years (3200 study hours) (depending on previous education)

Entry requirements

The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) basic vocational programme, or a comparable level.

7. Additional information

Optional subjects are linked to the qualification. The optional subjects have a total size of 15% of the course duration. The optional subjects completed by the student are listed on the certificate.
