4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The Public transport driver generally works for a transport company (public transport company). He transports people with a vehicle according to the timetable. This vehicle can be a large bus or a small van. The services are provided to anyone who wants to be transported. According to the Passenger Transport Act 2000, a public transport driver may only transport people in a vehicle if he is in possession of a medical certificate, not older than 5 years, from an occupational health and safety doctor. He must also be in possession of a certificate of good conduct.

Access to next level of education/professions

Career prospects for the Public transport driver consist primarily on transfer to taxi-driver, coach driver or coach driver/travel guide. To make these career moves, additional elements of these study courses must be followed. It is also possible, within the business, to advance and switch to an office position in the form of a planning or coordinating role (planner, control room operator).

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.

Average duration of the education/ training leading to the certificate

2 years (3200 study hours) (depending on previous education)

Entry requirements

The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) basic vocational programme, or a comparable level.

7. Additional information

Optional subjects are linked to the qualification. The optional subjects have a total size of 15% of the course duration. The optional subjects completed by the student are listed on the certificate.
