#### Access to next level of education/professions

The most obvious advancement for the Car spray painter is to progress to be a Skilled car spray painter. The Car spray painter can also advance to this position after several years of work experience. If the Car spray painter has the required competences, further advancement is possible to managerial positions such as head of spray painting, workshop manager or even company manager. The Car spray painter can also continue his career outside of the sector; for example as an Industry spray painter, in commercial or technical positions at suppliers/manufacturers of car paints or in the educational workfield (as car spray paint teacher).

### 6. Officially recognised ways of acquiring the certificate

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.

## Average duration of the education/ training leading to the certificate

2 years (3200 study hours) (depending on previous education)

#### Entry requirements

The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) basic vocational programme, or a comparable level.

## 7. Additional information

Dutch senior secondary VET is based on qualification files, that each contain one or more qualifications. The information included in part 3 and 4 is derived directly from the qualification file determined by the Minister of Education, Culture and Science.
