### 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The Dental nurse works in dental care. She provides support before, during and after patient treatment in organisations such as: general dental practice, hospitals (Oral diseases and surgery department), orthodontics practice and differentiated dental care such as periodontology practice. Other places where Dental nurses can work are: regional youth dental care institutions, nursing homes, dental hygienist's practices and (clinical) education at dental educations.

Access to next level of education/professions Through education and training a Dental nurse can specialise further to become a prevention assistant for example. The Dental nurse can possibly be exempted from certain parts of other VET level 4 educations, such as Nurse (general care) or Dental technician. The Dental technician can develop through higher general educations, such as Dental expert, which trains students to become a Dental hygienist.	International agreements Dental nurse is not a regulated profession in the Netherlands. However, the education and training for this profession on qualification level 4 is regulated under the European directive 2005/36/EC, amended by directive 2013/55/EU. The regulated education and training gives access to regulated professions at the level of a diploma according to article 11 of this directive

The education and training for this qualification is offered as of 01-08-2015.

## 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.

### Entry requirements

The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) advanced vocational programme, combined programme, or theoretical programme, or a comparable level.

### 7. Additional information

Dutch senior secondary VET is based on qualification files, that each contain one or more qualifications. The information included in part 3 and 4 is derived directly from the qualification file determined by the Minister of Education, Culture and Science. Optional subjects are linked to the qualification. The optional subjects have a total size of 15% of the course duration. The optional subjects completed by the student are listed on the certificate.
