4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The Bitumen and synthetics roofer works in the flat roof sector and works on external partition structures that are covered with bitumen and synthetics. The work is carried out in new construction, maintenance and renovation of civil and non-residential construction. The products and services are supplied to contractors, housing associations, (semi) government institutions and private individuals. The Bitumen and synthetics roofer can work for different types of companies: companies that specialise in covering with one or more material groups or companies that, in addition to that specialty, also carry out carpentry or plumbing work.

The certificate issued on completion of the programme is signed by the examination board at the school where the pupil attended the programme.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.

The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) basic vocational programme, or a comparable level.

7. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Dutch senior secondary VET is based on qualification files, that each contain one or more qualifications. The information included in part 3 and 4 is derived directly from the qualification file determined by the Minister of Education, Culture and Science. Optional subjects are linked to the qualification. The optional subjects have a total size of 15% of the course duration. The optional subjects completed by the student are listed on the certificate.
