The most important duties of a Commercial vehicle mechanic are:

Core task 1: Carries out maintenance on commercial vehicles

- 1.1 Prepares maintenance assignment on commercial vehicle
- 1.2 Carries out inspection of commercial vehicle
- 1.3 Carries out preventive maintenance on commercial vehicle
- 1.4 Installs accessories in commercial vehicle
- 1.5 Carries out technical adjustments on commercial vehicle
- 1.6 Checks their maintenance working duties and finishes off assignment

Core task 2: Carries out repairs to commercial vehicles

- 2.1 Prepares repair assignment in workplace or on location
- 2.2 Carries out repair to commercial vehicle in workplace
- 2.3 Makes diagnosis of commercial vehicle on location
- 2.4 Carries out (emergency) repairs to commercial vehicle on location
- 2.5 Checks their maintenance working duties and finishes off assignment
- 2.6 Gives technical explanations and advice about maintenance to client/ driver

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The Commercial vehicle mechanic is employed in the workshop of commercial vehicle companies, often based on industrial estates.

<p>Access to next level of education/professions There is a continuous learning line from levels 2 up to and including 4 within the senior secondary vocational education. Within the sector, similar transfer options are available from Commercial vehicle mechanic to the position of Skilled commercial vehicle mechanic. In addition to transfer, employees within the sector can also extend their knowledge in a specific field, for example by specialising in transport cooling, motor management or hydraulics. A graduate from senior secondary vocational education Commercial vehicle mechanics can also advance to non-technical aftersales positions such as service assistant (receptionist) and/or management positions such as workshop manager or service manager.</p>	<p>International agreements</p>

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE	
<p>Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbi). In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week. In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.</p>

<p>Entry requirements The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) basic vocational programme, or a comparable level.</p>
