3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The most important duties of a Coordinator port logistics are:

Core task 1: Carries out organising ship broker/shipping agent tasks

- 1.1 Organises the transport of goods
- 1.2 Organises the arrival, the ship's stay in and departure from the port

Core task 2: Carries out administrative ship broker/shipping agent tasks

- 2.1 Processes administrative data for the cargo/shipping file
- 2.2 Drafts documents for the cargo/shipping file and/or the transport process

Core task 3: Carries out commercial ship broker/shipping agent tasks

- 3.1 Makes contacts and maintains their network
- 3.2 Makes an inventory, provides information and advises the client

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

A Coordinator port logistics is working to become a ship broker or shipping agent and makes sure the operational process of a portion of the transports, arrivals and departures are processed properly.

The working tasks in port logistics mainly take place at a ship broker's or shipping agent's office. Organisations such as these are usually located near harbours, airports and other store and transhipment areas, foreign and domestic. The business of these organisations involves transporting wares through ships and other methods of transport.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.
