4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The All-round sign maker works as an employee or as an entrepreneur for a company in the sign sector or in the graphic sector or for a different company with a special sign department. These are service companies which handle the visual communication for several sectors.

The All-round sign maker could also work by order of advertising agencies, architects or display window agencies. The All-round sign maker carries out duties such as preparation, production, finishing, assembling and fitting of sign (part) products. He carries out his duties for several cliients.

Access to next level of education/professions The All-round sign maker can through courses be promoted to a sign specialist. He can also be recruited for a training (level 4) in this sector (Spatial design or Media design) if he seeks further specialization in the direction of design. The All-round sign maker can in medium-sized companies and large-sized companies be promoted to the position of a project leader, manager or department head. Legal basis	International agreements The profession of All-round sign maker is not regulated in the Netherlands. However the education and training for this profession on qualification level 3 is regulated under the European directive 2005/36/EC, amended by directive 2013/55/EU. The regulated education and training gives access to regulated professions at the level of a diploma according to article 11 of this directive.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.

Average duration of the education/ training leading to the certificate	3 years (4800 study hours) (depending on previous education)

Entry requirements

The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) advanced vocational programme, combined programme, or theoretical programme, or a comparable level.

7. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Dutch senior secondary VET is based on qualification files, that each contain one or more qualifications. The information included in part 3 and 4 is derived directly from the qualification file determined by the Minister of Education, Culture and Science. Optional subjects are linked to the qualification. The optional subjects have a total size of 15% of the course duration. The optional subjects completed by the student are listed on the certificate.
