The most important duties of a Basic preparation worker are:

Basic preparation workers can be deployed in the field of conventional and digital preparation. They are sufficiently conversant with conventional and digital methods, techniques and processes in preparation. They must also have an understanding of the total graphic production process and the role of the preparation worker in that process, to be able to consult with colleagues from other departments. Basic preparation workers are able to implement standard orders in an ergonomically-sound, safe and environmentally-aware manner, by applying automated routines and standard procedures. Depending on the order, they carry out their work under supervision, independently or as a team member. Basic preparation workers must be able to work accurately, check their own work and be capable of correcting any errors.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.
